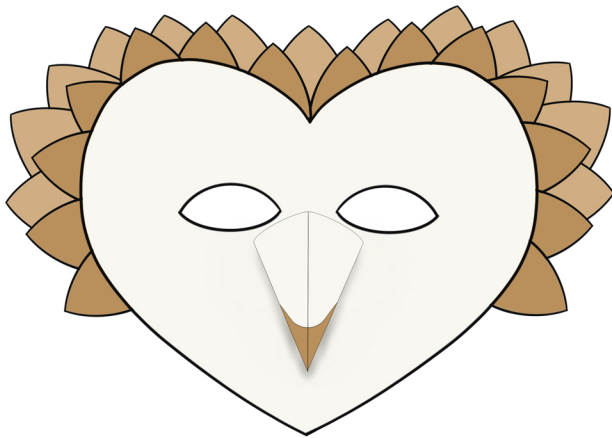


Make your own...



Nocturnal Animal Mask!

YOU WILL NEED:

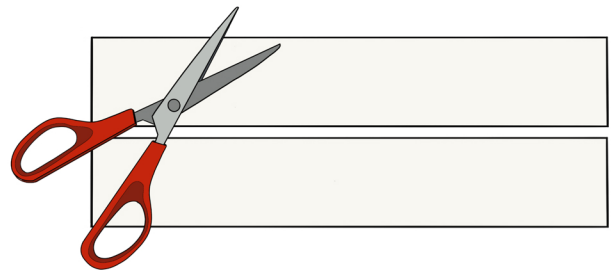
A4 coloured card or paper
A pencil
Scissors
A glue stick
Cellotape
Felt tip pens

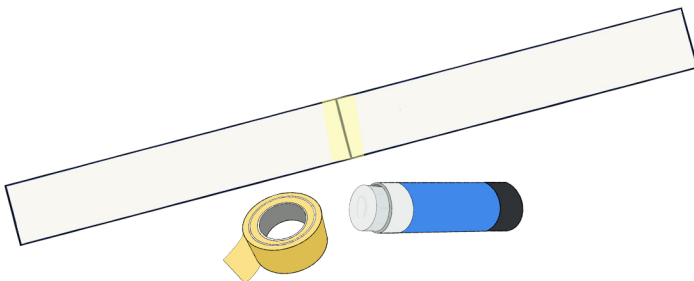

Cut out the two long strips from the mask template. These are going to become the headband of your mask.



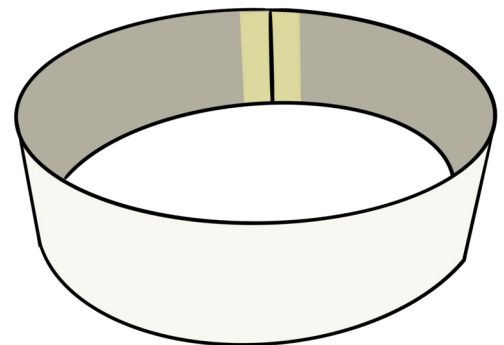

Stick these together using glue or cellotape to make one really long, thin strip.

Wrap the strip round your head to work out how big it needs to be to fit you comfortably. Tape it together. You now have the headband for your mask!

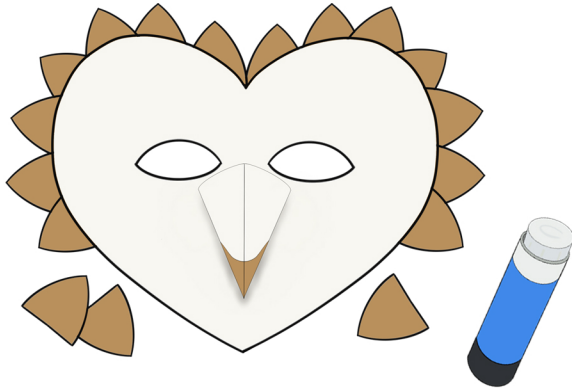
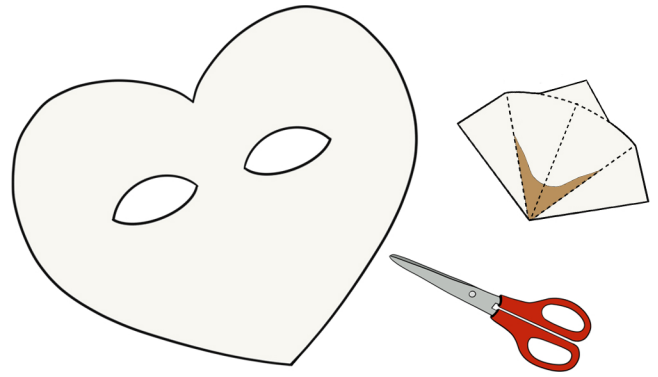

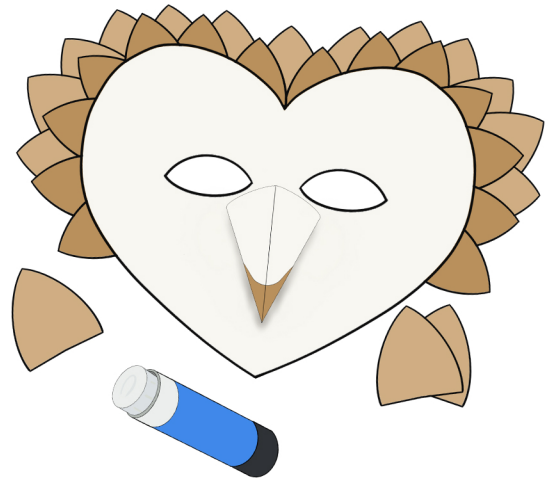

Cut out the owl face and beak from the template. Fold the beak in half. Fold the two side pieces inwards, and stick together to form a 3D beak. Attach to the mask with the small triangle at the top.



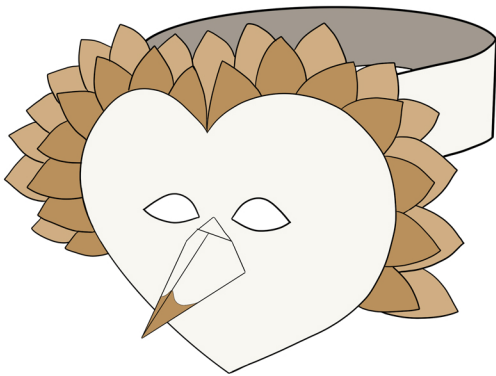

Cut out the small feathers and glue them to the back of the owl mask, making sure you can see them over the top!

Do the same with the large owl feathers so when you are finished you have a full, feathery owl head!

Add any other decoration using felt tip pens or coloured pencils. Then glue your owl mask to the headband, and your owl is complete!
