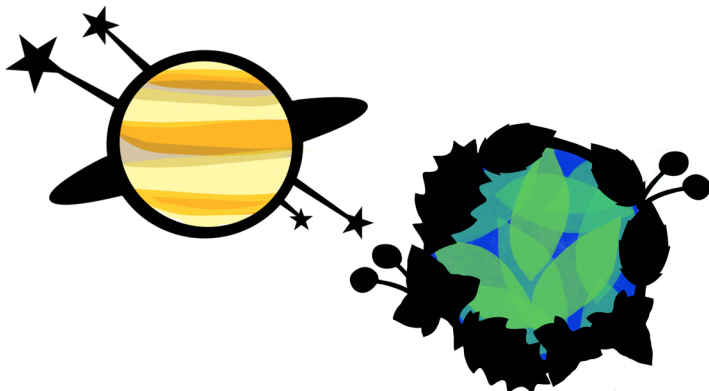

One fun and easy way to decorate your window is to cut simple shapes like stars and circles out of tissue paper. Experiment with sticking them on to the window with cellotape. What happens when different colours overlap?

You can also create frames out of black card or paper. You could make a frame with a celestial theme, like this one of Saturn. Or you could cut lots of leaves from black card to make a floral frame. Once you have made your frame, you can fill it with layers of colourful tissue paper!

You don't have to cut the tissue paper - try ripping it into large pieces that you overlap.

However, if you want something to look bright in a dark background, you will need to cut that shape out of the darker colour like the moon and stars below.

Or you could bring everything together to create a large picture that fills your window! You could play with how the different colours look when they overlap, both to the world outside and what they look like to you indoors.

If you shine a lamp towards your window picture it will help it to look brighter to the passers by!

It's completely up to you what the worlds you create in your windows are!
But here are some ideas that might inspire you...

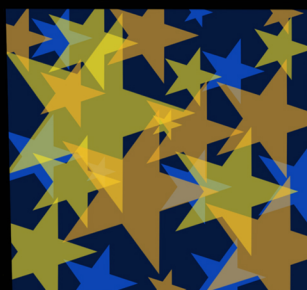
